*Weightroom Improvement

- o Approximately \$28,000
- o Includes racks, platforms, bumper plates, dumbbell rack, with addition dumbbells to ensure we have 2 sets of each weight.
- o After improvement plan, MS Weightroom will include 11 racks and 6 free standing platforms, for a total of 17 workout areas.
- o High School weightroom has 6 racks, for a total of 6 workout areas.
- o It will become an absolutely safer environment.

- o The athletic department agreed to purchase the materials up front with the understanding and agreement from the QBC to repay the athletic department on a payment plan. QBC budgeted \$5600 over 5 years interest free.
 - Questions presented to Geyer, could we pay back earlier if we fundraise specifically for the weight room program, could parking pass money apply to this repayment, could QBC be comped for money recovered if current equipment is sold.
