- Vote on Bylaw Changes
- *Old bylaws:* Terms of office shall be for one year. No member shall serve on the PTQB Club Board for more than two consecutive years without taking at least one year off in between each two year period.

- Proposed change: 7. Terms of office shall be for one year, and can be up to two consecutive years. A three-year term can be taken, if the majority (5/7 board members) are done with their service period at the same time. This need allows for people (s) to stay on the board for consistency, to not have the entire board transfer over at one time. No more than 2 members at a time can stay on for the third consecutive year. This exception would be voted on in the December membership meeting as well.
